



Statement Regarding Eastern Region 2 Representative Brent Digness from the Métis Nation–Saskatchewan Provincial Métis Council (PMC)

January 20, 2026

The Métis Nation–Saskatchewan Provincial Métis Council (PMC) wishes to provide an update regarding Eastern Region 2 Representative Brent Digness as it relates to the recordings made public the week of January 12, 2026.

Our government's Ethics Committee convened a meeting regarding the conduct of Mr. Brent Digness demonstrating an abuse of power, and containing harmful language regarding Métis citizens, women, and members of our broader community in the province of Saskatchewan.

Mr. Digness has acknowledged his actions in a public statement. As leaders of Métis Nation–Saskatchewan we further call on him to demonstrate that he will remain committed to healing and reconciliation.

Mr. Digness has acknowledged that, effective immediately, his position and duties as Eastern Region 2 Representative are suspended for an indeterminate period. Prior to consideration of reinstatement, the Ethics Committee will assess whether Mr. Digness has complied with all recommended measures including, but not limited to, the completion of a recommended treatment and therapy plan approved by the Ethics Committee. Mr. Digness will not be eligible for consideration of reinstatement for a period of no less than six months. These measures are consistent with the maximum allowable penalty under the PMC Conduct Policy.

Métis Nation–Saskatchewan upholds the values that guide us as Métis people. We want our Métis citizens, relatives, friends, neighbours and partners to know that we do not condone Mr. Digness' behaviour and the harm his actions have caused. Our actions to date reflect our duty to protect the wellbeing and humanity of others. We will continue to ensure that Métis values are embedded in every level of our government.
