



Statement Regarding the Conduct of Minister Brent Digness From President Glen McCallum, Métis Nation–Saskatchewan

January 13, 2026

To the citizens of Métis Nation–Saskatchewan and the general public,

I wish to speak directly to a matter that has caused concern within our community. Allegations of inappropriate conduct involving an elected official, Minister Brent Digness, have come to light. This is supported by audio recordings that are circulating publicly.

Our government does not condone this behaviour – no exceptions. Effective immediately, Minister Digness is removed from his portfolio as Minister of Economic Development, Tourism and Sports, Chair of the Clarence Campeau Development Fund (CCDF), and Saskatchewan Métis Economic Development Corporation (SMEDCO). I have assumed these responsibilities as this process unfolds. These actions are necessary to uphold the integrity of our government and to adhere to the values we hold as Métis people.

Building a strong government means holding each other accountable as elected leaders. Together, we have established procedures and laws including our PMC Conduct Policy. In this light, this matter has been referred to our MN–S Government's Ethics Committee.

While this situation is serious, it will not distract us from the important work ahead. I want to assure you that our government remains focused on advancing the rights and well-being of Métis citizens, and that all citizens are welcome to receive the benefits that our government offers.

Thank you for your understanding as we continue to work through this matter.
